

ENGLEWOOD WATER DISTRICT
RESOLUTION NO. 16-10-06 A

A Resolution of the ENGLEWOOD WATER DISTRICT ("DISTRICT") establishing the disbursement of funds received from the Legislature 2016-2017 General Appropriations Act for the project known as the **Englewood Water District Sewer Expansion Project**.

Recitals

- A. The Englewood Water District received appropriation of funds in the amount of \$350,000.00 of which \$300,000.00 will be made available for disbursement.
- B. The District intends to utilize the funds to establish a \$1,000.00 rebate/ incentive for residents who abandon their septic system and connect to the vacuum or gravity sewer system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the ENGLEWOOD WATER DISTRICT that;

1. This program will be available to those who meet all the following criteria on a first come first serve basis until the disbursement funds have been expended;

- (a) Individuals must be the current owner of the property and reside at the property
- (b) Property must be located in the V9-C Sewer Expansion Project Area
- (c) Connection to the vacuum sewer system must be made within 245 days from the date of the letter of availability. Proof of connection must be provided

2. In the event that the \$300,000.00 is not entirely disbursed to property owners in the V9-C Sewer Expansion Project Area within 245 days, remaining funds shall be made available for 90 days to property owners who meet all the following criteria;

- (a) Individuals must be the current owner of the property and reside at the property
- (b) Property must be located in the V9-A, V9-B or V9-C Sewer Expansion Project Area
- (c) Proof of connection to the vacuum sewer system must be provided


3. In the event that the \$300,000.00 is not entirely disbursed to property owners in the V9-A, V9-B or V9-C Sewer Expansion Project Areas remaining funds shall be made available for 30 days to property owners who meet all the following criteria;


- (a) Individuals must be the current owner of the property and reside at the property
- (b) Property must be located within District boundaries
- (c) Proof of connection to the vacuum or gravity sewer system must be provided

4. In the event that the \$300,000.00 is not entirely disbursed to property owners in the V9-C, V9-A or V9-B Sewer Expansion Project or property owners within District boundaries remaining funds shall become part of the EWD hardship fund.
